 he joined the new monastery at Citeaux and went  
 onto to found the Cistercian hose at Clairvaux.  
 He managed to combine a life of action with one  
 of mystical contemplation. Declared a Doctor of  
 the Church in 1830.

22<sup>nd</sup> August-Queenship of the Blessed Virgin  
 Mary. Pope PiusX11 instituted this feast in 1954,  
 to conclude what was then the Octave of the  
 Assumption. We remember that the Blessed  
 Virgin reigns in heaven, together with her Son;  
 she reigns not because she is equal to God bur  
 because she is the mother of Christ the King. All  
 her privileges come her Motherhood of God and  
 the unique role she played in our redemption.
