starting with Divine Mercy

Divine Mercy Sunday Prayers

with the aid of the Rosary beads:

1) The Sign of the Cross followed by Our Father....Hail Mary....the Apostles' Creed.

2) On the Our Father beads please say:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

3) On the ten Hail Mary beads please say:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have Mercy on us and on the whole world – repeat on all five sets of beads.

4) Say at the end three times: Holy God,

Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

5) Finally say the Three O'clock prayer:

You expired Jesus but the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

Say 3 times: *O Blood and Water which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I trust in You.*
